Charleston Coconut Pie

4 eggs beaten 1/2 cup self-rising flour
1 1/3 cups sugar 1/2 stick butter melted
2 cups milk 1 teaspoon vanilla
1 - 8 ounce can flake coconut

Preheat oven 350 degrees. Beat all ingredients together and pour into greased 10 inch pie plate. Bake 45 minutes. Though filling seems unsettled, do not cook pie longer. Refrigerate - will settle without spoiling its creamy consistency. Note: You may want to add more coconut for a richer coconut taste.
